2018 FLORIDA TRIP INFORMATION

Trip Check-In: 2:15 p.m. Wednesday, February 14

Trip Departure Time: 3:15 p.m.

Trip Return Time: Sunday, February 18
1:45 p.m. (approximate)

Health Information:

If student needs to take medication during the trip you will need to fill out a medication form. Any medication will need to be turned in to the school health room **no later than Friday, February 2**. Medication should be in a pharmacy prescribed container with just the amount of medication needed for the trip. If you would like your student to be able to receive ibuprofen or acetaminophen on the trip you will also need to fill out this form. These medications will be provided; you do not need to bring them in.

Luggage:

All participants will be allowed one small carry-on bag to bring on the bus and one suitcase to be stored inside the bus luggage area. Please do not bring extra luggage beyond this. We have limited space underneath the bus in which we also need to fit uniforms and instruments.

PLEASE NOTE: You will not have access to luggage stored under the bus until hotel check-in. You should pack some personal items (toothbrush and toothpaste, comb, deodorant, change of clothes, etc.) in your carry-on luggage because we will not be able to check in to the hotel until the afternoon of the first day. We will stop at a rest area on the morning of the first day to change clothes and freshen up.

Remember to pack:

1. Sunscreen!
2. Money for 2 meals - 3 breakfasts, 3 lunches, and 3 dinners are included in the trip. You will be responsible for paying for dinner on the way there and breakfast on the way back.
3. Spending money (souvenirs, etc.)
4. Clothes for 4 days. Clothing must be modest. Be sure to bring a jacket. Average temperatures in Orlando during the month of January are a high of 73 degrees and a low of 52 degrees. Be prepared just in case of weather extremes such as unusually cool temperatures or rain.
5. Comfortable shoes.
6. Rain gear.
7. Pillow and blanket (for sleeping on the way there and back).
8. Personal items – toiletries, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, comb, etc.

Movies on Bus:

Both buses will be equipped with a DVD player and movies will be shown while traveling. All movies must be G, PG, or PG-13 rated. Make sure your name is labeled on the DVD.

Uniform Responsibilities

1. Your uniform, shoes, and gloves will be packed for you.
2. Make sure that you have a pair of black socks in your uniform bag before we leave.

Itinerary:

RULES TO ABIDE BY:

1. Represent your school, your band, and yourself well. Do not do anything that will embarrass or cause trouble for any of us!
2. Obey the wishes of the Director, the Tour Guide, and the Chaperones at all times. Treat them with RESPECT.
3. Be on time for all check-ins! You will be required to check in with chaperones throughout the day when we are in the parks. Please be on time for these. Remember that the director and chaperones are responsible for you at all times.
4. NO USE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS!!
5. There will be a curfew each night. EVERYONE must be in their room by this time. NO EXCEPTIONS!
6. No male students in female rooms or female students in male rooms at any time!
7. Remember that this is a school trip. Any disciplinary problems will result in school disciplinary action when we return.
